Eligibility Requirements

To apply for the Grand Lodge of NC Knights of Pythias Scholarship, an applicant must:

<u>Graduating High School Seniors</u>: Attach an official (certified) academic transcript showing (1) your courses and grades through the Fall Term of your senior year in High School, (2) your class rank, and (3) the scores from your college entrance examinations (SAT or ACT)

<u>College and Graduate Students</u>: Attach an official (certified) academic transcript showing (1) your college courses through all completed academic terms, (2) credit hours received, and (3) the grade-point average through the Fall Term of the current academic year.

All Applicants:

Applicants must be a child, grandchild, step child or adopted child of a Knight with a minimum of 2 consecutive years of documented membership in a subordinate lodge as determined by the annual report membership roster.

The application must be signed by the Financial Secretary of the relative's Subordinate Lodge with the Lodge seal affixed to verify membership.

Leadership qualities and academic performance form an essential part of the review process and reflect the objectives sought by the Knights of Pythias.

How to Apply

Application forms for selection of the Grand Lodge of NC Knights of Pythias Scholarship are available from the Grand Lodge of NC Knights of Pythias website at www.glkopnc.org. The Knights of Pythias Scholarship Committee will notify selected applicants of the final decision each year.
